A. General Criteria of Eligibility

The applicant must be:

1. a natural-born Filipino citizen;
2. a poor, talented and deserving student who belongs to a family whose socio-economic status does not exceed the set values of certain indicators as approved by the Advisory Committee on the S&T Scholarships;
- 3.1 a member of the top five percent (5%) of the regular high school graduating class; **or**
- 3.2 a member of the graduating class of a DOST-SEI-identified or DepEd-recognized science high school;
4. a resident of the municipality for the last 4 years as attested by the barangay/school records;
5. of good moral character and in good health; and
6. a qualifier of the 2011 S&T Scholarship Examination.

The following are **NOT QUALIFIED** to apply:

1. those who have earned units in any post-secondary/undergraduate course;
2. those who have taken any DOST-SEI Science and Technology Scholarship Examination; and
3. those who have applied for immigrant status in the USA or any other country.

B. Scholarship Privileges

- a) Tuition and other school fees not to exceed P6,000.00/semester/term
- b) Allowance for prescribed textbooks and essential school supplies at P5,000.00/academic year
- c) Outright grant for prescribed Physical Education uniform of P500.00 for first semester of the first year only
- d) Free transportation for one economy-class round trip fare between permanent residence and place of study on reimbursement basis (for those studying outside of home province)
- e) Monthly living allowance for a 10-11 month duration
 - For those who will pursue BS Physics/Applied Physics, Physics Teaching, BS Geology/Mining Engineering, a monthly living allowance of P5,000.00.
 - For those who will pursue other DOST-SEI priority courses, a monthly living allowance of P4,000.00.
- f) Group health and accident insurance
- g) Additional privileges during summer, if required in the curriculum, such as:
 - Monthly living allowance during the period
 - Tuition and other school fees not to exceed P1,500.00
 - Actual purchase of textbooks and essential school supplies not to exceed P500.00 (official receipts required)
- h) Post-graduation clothing allowance at P1,000.00

C. Items to be Submitted

- a) DOST-SEI Information Sheet (Form A)
- b) Household Profile Questionnaire (Form B)
- c) Certification of Good Moral Character from the Guidance Counselor/Principal (Form C)
- d) Certification from the Principal on the following:
 - That the applicant belongs to the upper 5% of the regular high school graduating class (Form D-1); **or**
 - That the applicant belongs to the graduating class of a DOST-SEI identified or DepEd-recognized science high school (Form D-2)
 - Total number of candidates for graduation
- e) Statement of applicant that he/she has not taken any undergraduate or post secondary course (Form E)
- f) Statement of parent that applicant has no pending application as immigrant to the USA or any other country (Form F)
- g) Certification of Residency from barangay captain (Form G)
- h) Two recent identical photographs (1"x1") taken within the month of application period, one to be attached to the DOST-SEI Information Sheet and the other to the Test Permit.
- i) Photocopy of Birth Certificate

All certifications are found in the application form.

D. Where to Secure/File Application

- The application form can be obtained at the Science Education Institute, 3rd Floor, PTRI Bldg., Bicutan, Taguig City, Metro Manila; DOST Regional Offices; Provincial Science and Technology Centers (PSTC) or Offices of the Congressmen. It can be downloaded also at the website, www.sei.dost.gov.ph
- Accomplished form can be filed at the Science Education Institute, or DOST Regional Office/PSTC nearest the applicant's school or home address.

Date of Examination:

21 November 2010 (Sunday)

2nd batch 1:00 PM - 6:00 PM

The Test Permit/s shall be mailed to the applicant or school principal for distribution to the applicants. In case the test permits are not received before the examination day, the examinees may check with the DOST Regional Office/PSTC a day before the examination and proceed to the nearest designated test center.

E. Scholarship Requirements

- a) **An awardee must seek admission and enroll at any of the state universities and colleges and tertiary institutions identified as CHED Centers of Excellence/Centers. He/She should pass the qualifying examination for admission by the university where he/she plans to enroll.**
- b) An awardee shall comply with the terms of the Scholarship Agreement to be entered into between himself/herself, parents or legal guardian and the DOST-SEI.
- c) After signing the Scholarship Agreement, the awardee's name shall be included in the lists of scholars needing clearance from DOST-SEI forwarded to the Department of Foreign Affairs, National Bureau of Investigation and Bureau of Immigration.
- d) An awardee shall maintain the grade requirement of the scholarship.
- e) Upon completion of his/her course, an awardee shall serve in the country preferably in his/her home region on full-time basis along his/her field of training for a minimum period equivalent to the length of time he/she enjoyed the scholarship.

F. Examination Coverage

This is an aptitude test designed to measure abilities that determine academic and professional success in science, mathematics and engineering. The test is divided into two major components:

1. Intellectual

Scientific Ability; Quantitative Ability; Mechanical and Technical Ability; Linguistic Ability; Imagery; Inspection; Working Memory; and Sensorimotor Ability


2. Non-Intellectual

G. Selection Criteria

The awardees shall be selected on the basis of their performance in the 2011 S & T Scholarship Examination.

H. Final Selection

The list of awardees as approved and announced by the DOST Secretary is final and unappealable.
